Safety Information

- For your safety, please respect and listen to Cascades staff operating games and activities.

- Speed Limit: 15mph or slower horses, bikes, and kids are around!
- **Pets:** Pets must be kept on a leash, quiet, and may not enter any buildings. Please clean up after your furry friends!
- Hiking: Hiking to Fossil Rock is restricted, but enjoy our other trails!
- Swimming: Swim only when lifeguards are on-duty (see page 2).
- **Boats:** Children under 13 yrs must be accompanied by an adult. All boaters must wear life jackets.

- No food or beverages inside Rainier Center or Summit Chapel. (Covered beverages are okay. Please let us know if you spill!)
- Wristbands: Meal plan participants will be asked to show wristbands for entry to the dining room for all meals: <u>Green</u> - all meals | <u>Yellow</u> - dinners only | <u>Red</u> - BBQs only | <u>Blue</u> - day guests (day guests must provide meal tickets for meals)
- **BBQs:** All registered guests are welcome at the Thursday Beef BBQ and the Sunday Salmon BBQ. Please wear your wristbands!
