## Everything You Need to Know:



- **Wristbands:** Registered guests will have green wristbands. Registered guests on the meal plan will have yellow wristbands. Day guests must register with the office, and will have red wristbands.
- Meal Times: Breakfast: Sat/Sun/Mon 8am | Lunch: Sat/Sun 12pm | Dinner: Sat/Sun 5:30pm
- Espresso Hours: Sat/Sun 7:30-9:30am & 11:30am-1:30pm | Mon 7:30-9:30am | Closed at mealtimes
- Gift Store Hours: Sat 8:30-9:30am & 12:30-1:30pm | Sun 12:30-1:30pm | Mon 8:30-9:30am
- WiFi: Free WiFi is available around Nisqually Center & lodges. For cell reception, try near main entrance.
- Waterfront: Sat/Sun boating, fishing, & swimming. Swim only when lifeguards are on duty (1-5pm). All boaters must wear life jackets. Boaters under 13 yrs must be accompanied by an adult.
- Campfire & S'mores: Fri/Sat/Sun 7-8pm | Liberty Ridge & Timber Rock Amphitheater
- Tiki Torch Waterslide: Sat/Sun 7-8pm | Liberty Ridge
- Pony Rides: Sat/Sun 1-2pm | Sunrise Ranch | 9 yrs and younger. No sign-up necessary!
- Trail Rides: Sat 10am, 1pm, & 2:30pm | Sun 1pm & 2:30pm | Age 10+. Sign up & pay \$18\*. Must wear long pants & sturdy shoes, and be able to mount unassisted from the ground.
- **Zip Lines:** Sat/Sun 1pm | Sign up & pay \$8\*. Weight limits (apply to single & tandem) = min 80 lbs/max 250 lbs. Tandem riders must be 5+ yrs & ride with a parent/guardian.
- Paintball: Sat 2:30pm | Sign up & pay \$15\*
- Sauna: Sat/Sun 3pm | Sign up & pay \$3\*
- Climbing Tower: Sun 2:30pm | Sign up & pay \$7\*
- **Self-Serve Activities:** Volleyball, basketball, tennis, frisbee, frisbee golf, pickle ball, hiking, biking, gaga ball, running, playground, etc. (Rec. equipment available by pop machine at Nisqually Center.)
- **Sunday Morning Worship Service:** 10am in Summit Chapel. (We'll be taking an offering for our camper sponsorship fund, so don't forget your wallet if you feel led to give.)
- Camp Ends: Monday at 11am. (Cabin quests, please leave keys at the espresso stand.)
- \*Activities sign-ups begin at 8:30am each day outside Rainier Center. After 9am, head to espresso stand instead.

## Campground Information:



- Campsites are not assigned, but please limit your space to one site.
- Pets must be kept on leash and quiet, and must stay outside. Clean up after your furry friends, please!
- Outdoor kitchen behind Liberty Ridge Center: cook your meal, clean up, then please make room to allow others to use the space. Place your used charcoal in the fire-proof metal garbage can provided.
- No fires (including above-ground pits) at individual campsites, please. Propane fires are allowed.
- Carpet ball is open from 9am-9pm.
- No alcohol, fireworks, or weapons.
- No ATVs, please. Bicycles welcome, but must stay on paved roads. Obey speed limits and legal carrying capacities, and respect the peace and quiet of others, please!
- Drive slowly (10-15mph) and watch out for bikes! Keep driving to a minimum whenever possible.
