



# Rainier Kids Day Camp Information

## DROP-OFF:

- **Check-In:** Plan to arrive at 9 am and watch for signs directing you to our express check-in staff. During express check-in, please stay in your vehicle and a staff member will approach your window.
- **Bus Transport:** If you have registered for bus transport, our van will be at Crossroads Community Covenant Church at 8:30 am.
- **Early Drop-Off:** If you have registered for early drop-off, please drive all the way down our main road to Nisqually Center and meet our staff there. On the camper's first day we will be performing precautionary head-checks. If you're running late or your camper can't come on a certain day, please give our office a call or email [registrar@cascadescamp.org](mailto:registrar@cascadescamp.org) and we'll let our Rainier Kids staff know.

## PICK-UP:

- **Check-Out:** Plan to pick your camper up at 4 pm from our Easy Street location. Only pre-designated adults may pick up campers.
- **Bus Transport:** If you have registered for bus transport, our vans will be at Crossroads Community Covenant Church at 4:30 pm.
- **Late Pick-Up:** If you have registered for late pick-up and you arrive after 5 pm, please drive all the way down our main road to Nisqually Center and meet our staff there.

## PACKING:

Your camper should bring a backpack, and have these things inside—

- Sunscreen & bug spray
- Water bottle
- Swimsuit & towel
- DO NOT BRING: valuables, cell phones, personal electronics, or knives

## CAMPER MEALS:

- **Dietary Restrictions:** If your camper has any dietary restrictions, please make note of that on your registration, and we will do our best to accommodate for it.
- **Early Drop-Off/Late Pick-Up Meals:** Lunch is provided for all campers. If you have registered for early drop-off and arrive before 8 am, breakfast is provided. If you have registered for late pick-up and arrive after 5:30 pm, dinner is provided.

## SPENDING MONEY:

- **Deposits:** To keep your camper's funds safe and conveniently accessible during free time, deposit their funds in a spending account, with a maximum of \$50. Spending money may be deposited ahead of arrival or during camper drop-off on the first day of the week.
- **Canteen:** Campers may have up to two visits per day to purchase snacks and cold drinks, or vote to "ice bucket" a staff member by donating to the summer mission project. Canteen prices typically average \$0.50 - \$5.00 per item.
- **Gift Store:** We offer gift items, books, shirts, toiletries, and more. These purchases may be debited from campers' Canteen account.
- **Unused Funds:** On the last day of camp, any remaining funds are returned to the camper or can be donated to our summer mission project or sponsorship fund.

## ACCOUNT BALANCES:

- Outstanding balances must be paid two weeks prior to arrival. To pay, either (a) log on to your online account, (b) mail a check, or (c) provide your card information and authorize a payment by calling the office or emailing [registrar@cascadescamp.org](mailto:registrar@cascadescamp.org).
